

REGULATIONS FOR USE OF THE CAMPSITE AREA, THE CAR PARK FOR VEHICLES OF PERSONS USING THE CAMPSITE, AND PARKING SPACES FOR CAMPERS

1. These Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulations") are issued by the Organizer of the event named Łódź Summer Festival (hereinafter referred to as the "Event"), which will take place on 24-26 July 2026. The period of operation of the campsite area, the car park for vehicles of persons using the campsite, and the parking spaces for campers and motor vehicles with a camping trailer (hereinafter referred to as the "Area") is from 24 July 2026 at 12:00 to 27 July 2026 at 12:00 in Łódź, on the municipal green area at the junction of Juszcakiewicza and Kusocińskiego Streets, operated by Aqua Park Łódź Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Łódź at ul. Unii Lubelskiej 4, 94-208 Łódź (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer").

2. These Regulations are addressed to all persons who will be present in the Area during its period of operation specified in item 1. Every person present in the Area during the Event is obliged to comply with these Regulations.

3. The purpose of these Regulations is to ensure the safety of Participants staying in the Area by defining the rules of conduct and use of the Area and its infrastructure. In addition, the purpose of these Regulations is to regulate the rights and obligations of Users while staying in the Area in connection with the purchase of the appropriate Ticket.

4. The following terms used in these Regulations have the following meanings:

4.1. Ticket for a parking space for a camper-type vehicle - a document issued by the Operator confirming the right to enter the Area with a Camper-type vehicle or a motor vehicle with a camping trailer, in the form of an electronic PDF ticket.

4.2. Ticket for a tent space for one person and their tent - a document issued by the Operator confirming the Client's right to stay at the Campsite, in the form of an electronic PDF ticket.

4.3. Ticket for a car space and for a tent space for one person and their tent - a document issued by the Organizer confirming the right to enter the Area with a vehicle other than a Camper or a motor vehicle with a camping trailer, in the form of an electronic PDF ticket.

4.4. User - a person entitled to enter and stay in the Area on the basis of a Ticket.

4.5. Security Services - employees of a security or property protection agency, or other persons appointed by the Organizer to ensure the safety of Users in the Area and to make decisions on behalf of the Organizer, including persons authorised to verify the rights of Users or other persons to enter the Area.

§ 1. General provisions

5. The following persons are entitled to use the Area: (i) adults, (ii) minors who are at least 16 years old, only after presenting a completed statement of their statutory representatives consenting to participation in the Event and accepting full responsibility, including financial responsibility, for the minor's conduct, and (iii) minors aged from 4 to 16, who may stay in the Area only under the care and at the sole responsibility of a statutory representative or another authorised adult, after that person signs, before the first entry to the Area, a statement accepting full responsibility, including financial responsibility, for the minor's conduct. The above statements must be submitted before the first entry to the Area, in a place designated by the Organizer. The template statement constitutes Appendix No. 1 to these Regulations.

6. One ticket for a tent space authorises only one person to stay in the Area. It is prohibited to transfer a Ticket to third parties without the prior consent of the Organizer.

7. The User is obliged to comply with these Regulations and follow the instructions of the Security Services.

8. The provisions of the Road Traffic Act apply in the Area and on access and internal roads, and the maximum speed limit is 10 km/h. Only motor vehicles with a gross vehicle weight not exceeding 3.5 t may be parked in the Area.

9. Consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited in the Area. Staff may refuse entry, acceptance of a vehicle, or release of a vehicle to persons whose condition indicates alcohol consumption.

§ 2. Arrival and departure of Users

10. Entry to the Area is possible only upon presentation of Tickets.

11. During ticket control, a valid photo document confirming the identity of its holder must be presented. After successfully passing ticket control, subject to item 12 of these Regulations, each User receives an LSF Camp wristband from the Organizer, authorising multiple entries to the Area.

12. The Organizer reserves the right, due to special safety measures, to subject every person entering the Area to a security check, including inspection of the vehicle and luggage.

13. The Area is intended exclusively for tents, campers and camping trailers. The number of plots is limited.

14. Pitching a tent and parking a camper or camping trailer is possible only in the places designated by the Organizer. When pitching a tent or parking a camper or camping trailer, the User is obliged to maintain an appropriate distance between camps.

15. The area for campers and camping trailers will be separated within the Area. It will not be possible to pitch a tent directly next to a camper or camping trailer.

16. The Organizer informs that the campsite consists of two types of plots: (i) plots measuring approximately 2.5 m by 2 m (for 1-2 person tents) and (ii) plots measuring approximately 2.5 m by 4 m (for 3-4 person tents).

17. After parking, the engine of the camper, motor vehicle, and vehicle delivering the camping trailer must remain switched off at all times.

18. A User using a parking space is obliged to have valid third-party liability insurance (OC) for the holder of the motor vehicle, appropriate for the motor vehicle parked in the Area. Lack of a valid OC policy may constitute grounds for refusing entry to the Area.

19. An additional fee of PLN 300 will be charged for occupying a space other than the designated one or for parking a car, camper or camping trailer improperly, in particular by occupying two parking spaces as a result of crooked parking outside the designated places marking the width of the parking space. The same fee applies on analogous terms in the event of pitching a tent improperly.

20. The User is obliged to leave the Area within the time indicated in the Reservation. A User of the Area who exceeds the parking or stay time is obliged to pay an additional fee according to the price list available in the Area.

21. The User of the Area is obliged, with due care, to keep outside the vehicle or tent the vehicle registration certificate and all keys, chips, magnetic cards, etc. used to start or open the vehicle or tent, or to disable security devices. The use by an unauthorised person of stolen documents, keys, chips, magnetic cards, etc. releases the Organizer from liability for damages.

22. The User of a vehicle and tent is obliged to secure the vehicle and tent against access by unauthorised persons and to use - if installed - the vehicle security systems.

23. If it is necessary to open a vehicle or tent by invasive means, non-standard attempts to access its interior may be undertaken by the User only after presenting documents confirming ownership of the vehicle or tent.

§ 3. Organizational and order rules

24. The Organizer ensures order and safety in the Area through the presence of the Organizer's Security Services and hygienic and sanitary facilities with running water (only for the campsite).

25. Employees of the Security and Information Services and representatives of the Organizer may issue their own safety and fire safety instructions in accordance with applicable law.

26. The following is prohibited:

26.1. Taking any actions that may disrupt the functioning of the Area;

26.2. Pitching tents or parking campers, cars and camping trailers outside the plots indicated by the Organizer;

26.3. Littering the Area;

26.4. Using gas cylinders and open flame in tents;

26.5. Lighting bonfires and grilling;

26.6. Using electrical devices without the Organizer's consent (electric kettles, heaters, dryers, etc.);

26.7. Connecting to the existing electricity network, except in the designated place;

26.8. Interfering with the surrounding greenery (other than movement by Users resulting from the nature of the Area);

- 26.9. Performing operational activities on motor vehicles such as washing or changing fluids;
- 26.10. Devastating the infrastructure of the Area;
- 26.11. Disturbing order;
- 26.12. Bringing in or driving in any dangerous items, including weapons, flammable materials and pyrotechnic materials;
- 26.13. Bringing in alcoholic beverages, narcotic drugs, legal highs or other substances with similar effects;
- 26.14. Bringing in food and beverages in glass packaging;
- 26.15. Bringing in animals, except assistance dogs upon presentation by a person with a disability of a certificate confirming the assistance dog status and a certificate confirming the required vaccinations;
- 26.16. Parking non-roadworthy vehicles, including vehicles with leaks;
- 26.17. Using drone-type devices (devices controlled remotely or performing autonomous flight, used mainly for observation or recording) or any other object floating in the air.
- 27. Users who do not comply with the above rules, who possess the above-mentioned items, who do not follow the instructions of the Security Services, or who fail to comply with these Regulations will not be admitted to the Area or will be removed from it, without any refund for Tickets.
- 28. The Security Services designated by the Organizer are authorised, among other things, to:
 - 28.1. Verify the right to stay in the Area;
 - 28.2. Conduct security checks, including inspection of vehicles and luggage;
 - 28.3. Issue order instructions in order to ensure safety;
 - 28.4. Remove persons from the Area in the event of non-compliance with the Regulations;
 - 28.5. Detain a person when permitted by generally applicable law, in order to hand the person over to the Police, in particular if the User poses a threat to human health or life or exposes Users' property to risk.
- 29. Conducting commercial or advertising activity in the Area is prohibited, except in situations agreed with the Organizer.
- 30. In the event of any irregularities or observed threats, all information should be addressed to the Security Services.

§ 4. Liability and deposit

- 31. Users of the Area are obliged to take care of their property and personal belongings. The Organizer is not liable for items left in vehicles or tents.
- 32. Users may not leave their property and personal belongings unsecured.
- 33. The User of the Area bears full liability for all damage and destruction caused through the User's fault.
- 34. The Organizer is not liable for damage caused by force majeure or by the fault of the injured party or other Users for whom the Organizer is not responsible.
- 35. The User is responsible for any personal injury and property damage caused through the User's fault and is therefore obliged to remedy such damage in accordance with general rules.
- 36. The User of the Area is liable for all damage (scratches, dents, etc.) caused to other vehicles belonging to third parties. If such damage is caused by the User, the User should immediately report this fact to the Security Services and provide their own third-party liability insurance policy for the purpose of settling the claim. Failure to report causing damage to another vehicle may expose the User to criminal liability.
- 37. The Organizer bears no financial liability for items lost, left behind or stolen in the Area - this does not apply where an item is the subject of a deposit agreement concluded between the User and the Organizer (for example, items left by Users in the deposit available to Users of the campsite), or where the Organizer has found an item or performs duties with respect to the management of found property as provided for in the Act on Found Property.
- 38. Lost items should be reported to the Security Services. Items lost or left in the Area, if found by the Security Services or handed over by a third party to the Security Services, may be collected from the lost property office located in the Aqua Park Łódź Sp. z o.o. building at ul. Unii Lubelskiej 4, 94-208 Łódź, within 30 days of being found.
- 39. In the event of damage, claims will be considered only if the matter is reported before the User leaves the parking space/campsite plot designated on the day of arrival. Claims will not be considered if, before the damage is reported, the User leaves the parking space and/or leaves the car park area or leaves the

campsite plot.

40. The deposit is available only to Users of the campsite. The deposit is handled using special envelopes intended exclusively for storing small items, including only: documents, keys, telephone and personal jewellery. The total value of items deposited by one User may not exceed PLN 500. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse to accept any item for deposit if the Organizer is unable to ensure its safety.

§ 5. Additional infrastructure for campsite Users

41. In designated zones, the Organizer may provide the following for campsite Users:

41.1. Shower cabins and toilets;

41.2. Deposit;

41.3. Paid catering points;

41.4. Mobile phone charging point.

42. The User may use the above amenities only in accordance with their intended purpose, taking into account the rules for using such devices, as well as the rules of maintaining order and respecting other persons using such devices or parts of the infrastructure.

§ 6. Complaints

43. The Organizer considers properly submitted complaints without delay, no later than within 14 days from the date of their delivery in a manner enabling identification of the person submitting the complaint.

44. The administrator of personal data processed in connection with a submitted complaint is the Organizer. Personal data are processed solely for the purpose of considering complaints. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to consider the complaint and receive a response to it. The legal basis for processing personal data is that processing is necessary for the purposes resulting from the legitimate interests pursued by the Organizer, consisting in considering complaints. The Organizer may process Participants' personal data for as long as necessary to achieve the purposes for which the data were collected, unless there is a technical, legal or other important reason justifying the deletion, destruction or anonymisation of such data.

45. The data subject has the right to request from the Organizer access to their personal data, rectification, erasure or restriction of processing, the right to object to processing, the right to data portability, and the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

§ 7. Final provisions

46. Before leaving the campsite or parking space, the User is obliged to clean and leave undamaged the place where the User stayed.

47. In matters not regulated by these Regulations or by the Regulations for Reservation of Campsite Spaces, Parking Spaces for Persons Using the Campsite, and Parking Spaces for Campers made via the portal <https://www.lodzsummerfestival.pl>, generally applicable law shall apply.

48. In matters not regulated by these Regulations, final decisions on organizational matters belong to the authorised representatives of the Organizer.

49. The Organizer has the right to amend these Regulations, in particular due to the need to ensure the proper conduct of the Event and operation of the Area, as well as the safety of Participants.
