

PARKING USE REGULATIONS

1. The car park is available 24/7. The car park is not monitored.
2. The User is obliged to comply with the parking regulations and follow the instructions of the car park staff.
3. The Service Provider is not liable for items left in vehicles.
4. The User is obliged to leave the car park within the time indicated in the Reservation.
5. Parking may take place only in the designated space.
6. By entering the car park, the vehicle User accepts the terms set out in these Regulations, undertakes to strictly comply with their provisions, and confirms that the vehicle has valid third-party liability insurance (OC).
7. The car park may be used by holders of cars with a gross vehicle weight of up to 3.5 t, motorcycles, quads, trailers and bicycles (hereinafter referred to as "vehicles").
8. An additional fee of PLN 300 will be charged for occupying a space other than the designated one or for parking a vehicle improperly, in particular by occupying two parking spaces as a result of crooked parking outside the designated posts marking the width of the parking space.
9. A vehicle User who exceeds the parking time is obliged to pay an additional fee according to the price list available at the car park.
10. If it is necessary to open a vehicle by invasive means, non-standard attempts to access its interior may be undertaken by the customer only after presenting documents confirming ownership of the vehicle.
11. The car park User is obliged, with due care, to keep outside the vehicle the vehicle registration certificate and all keys, chips, magnetic cards, etc. used to start or open the vehicle or disable security devices. The use by an unauthorised person of stolen documents, keys, chips, magnetic cards, etc. releases the Service Provider from liability for damages.
12. Consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited within the car park. The staff may refuse admission to the car park or refuse to release a vehicle from the car park to persons whose condition indicates alcohol consumption.
13. The vehicle User is obliged to secure the vehicle against access by unauthorised persons and to use the security systems installed in the vehicle.
14. The provisions of the Road Traffic Act apply in the car park and on access and internal roads, and the maximum speed limit is 10 km/h.
15. Vehicles carrying flammable, corrosive, explosive materials, etc. are strictly prohibited from entering the car park.
16. The Service Provider is not liable for damage caused by reasons inherent in a vehicle defect, for example a fire caused by a faulty electrical installation.
17. The car park User is liable for all damage (scratches, dents, etc.) caused to other vehicles belonging to third parties. If such damage is caused by the User, the User should immediately report this fact to the car park staff and provide their own third-party liability insurance policy for the purpose of settling the claim. Failure to report causing damage to another vehicle may expose the User to criminal liability.
18. In the event of damage, claims will be considered only if the matter is reported before the vehicle leaves the parking space designated on the day of arrival. Claims will not be considered if, before the damage is reported, the vehicle leaves the parking space and/or leaves the car park area.
19. Washing cars, replacing or draining fluids, fuel or oil, and polluting the car park are prohibited in parking spaces.
20. The car park User bears full liability for damage caused to third parties within the car park, as well as for any culpable pollution of the car park.
